Director's Report (Ackerman)

There has been a lot that has taken place with funding and the state budget between the last meeting. There was a possibility that GNETS funding would be changed to the QBE meaning we would not have to submit a state grant; however, that was not voted on. We do now have to submit a state grant and we have a meeting to review details on May 3rd. There is an expectation that there is a likelihood that fiscal year 24, next budget meeting in the spring, will result in a refunneling of finances. There is a proposal deadline for GNETS in the fall. Mr. Ackerman will keep the team updated and we will proceed with the state grant for fiscal year 2023. We have an upcoming walkthrough from a PBIS representative who helps determine our PBIS status. Please see your emails regarding comments for our graduates to be submitted.
