










Putting Together Pop-up Books

Materials

For each student you will need:

- copies of text and illustrations
- markers or crayons
- scissors
- glue
- 9" x 12" construction paper for cover

Assembly Directions


<p>1. Color the illustrations.</p> 	<p>2. Cut out the illustrations.</p> 
<p>3. Fold a piece of construction paper in half to serve as the front and back covers of the book.</p> 	<p>4. Cut out and glue the cover page to the center-front of the book cover.</p> 
<p>5. Fold each interior page in half on the solid line. The top of the page should be folded to the back so that the dashed lines are visible for cutting.</p> 	<p>6. Cut along the dashed lines, being sure to cut through both layers of the folded paper. Cut all the way to the large dots.</p> 
<p>7. Open the page and fold it back the other way, holding the cut section between your fingers, keeping it folded. Close the page, flattening the cut part so that when you re-open the page, it will be "popped up."</p> 	<p>8. Spread glue over gray box and attach the illustration. Note: In order to ensure that the illustration does not bend when the book closes, glue it so it extends beyond the pop-up.</p> 
<p>9. Arrange the pages in numerical order. Glue the back of one page to the front of the other until all are together as a booklet.</p> 	<p>10. Glue the booklet to the inside of the cover.</p>









George Washington grew up in Virginia. He was good at math.
His first job was measuring the land. He was a surveyor.




He was such a great soldier in the French and Indian War, he was asked to be a general in the Revolutionary War.




In 1789, George Washington was elected the first president of the United States.




Our nation's capital, Washington, D.C., was named after our first president. In 1800, the Washington Monument was completed in his honor.




George Washington's face is seen on the one-dollar bill and the quarter. He is recognized as the Father of Our Country.




